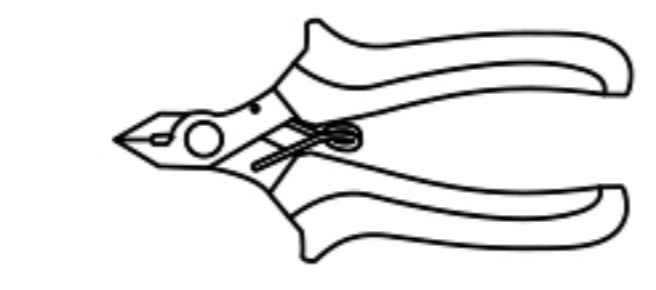

**Legends:**

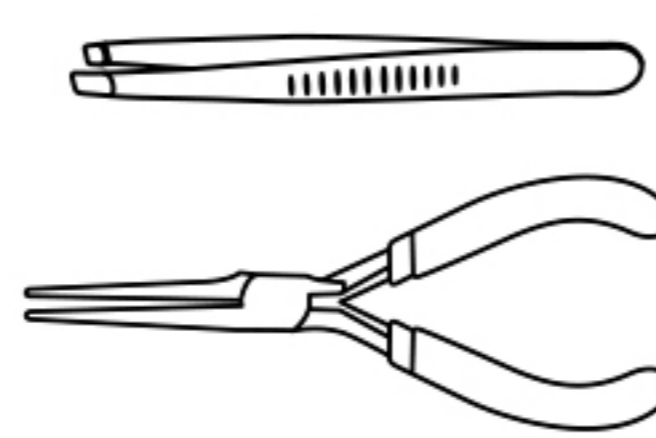
- Engraved side
- Non-engraved side
- Attention point
- Insert tab and bend 90 degrees
- Insert tab and twist 90 degrees

**Recommended tools:**

-Wire cutters: helpful for taking parts from the metal sheets.

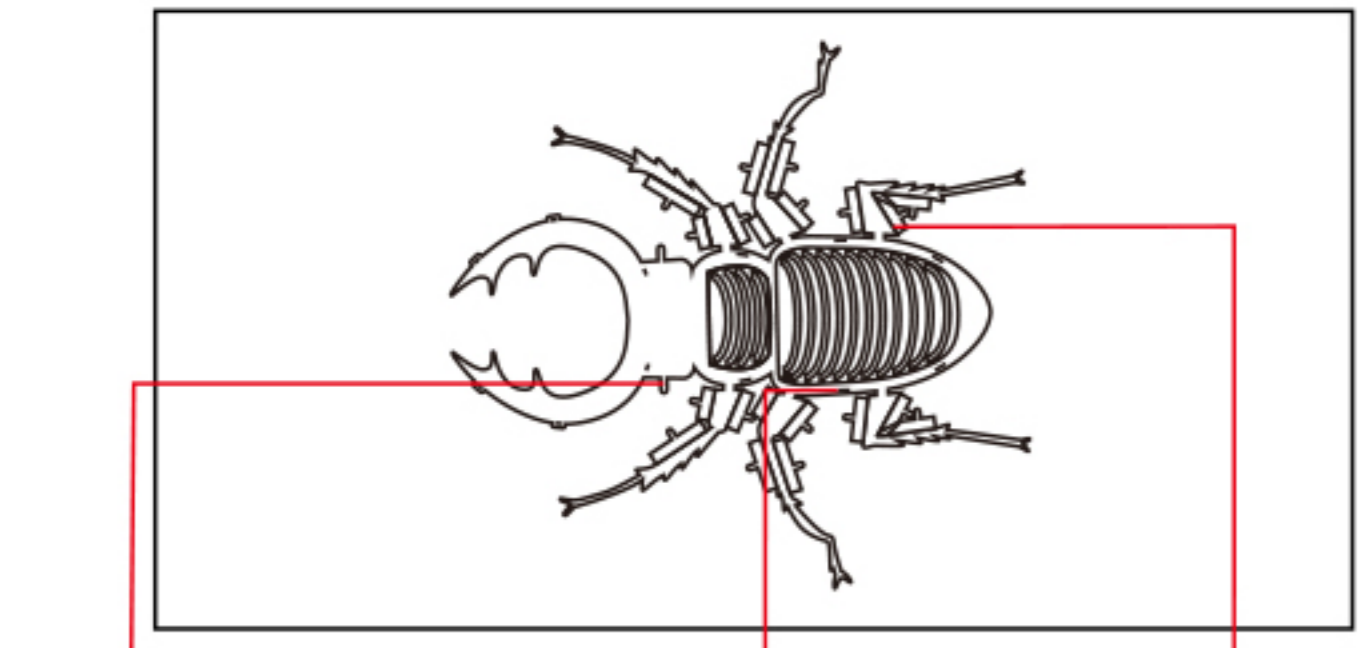


-Tweezers or needle nose pliers: helpful for folding parts, bending and twisting tabs.



**Assembly tip:**

If needed, slightly twist tabs to hold parts together then untwist and bend them down for a nice finish

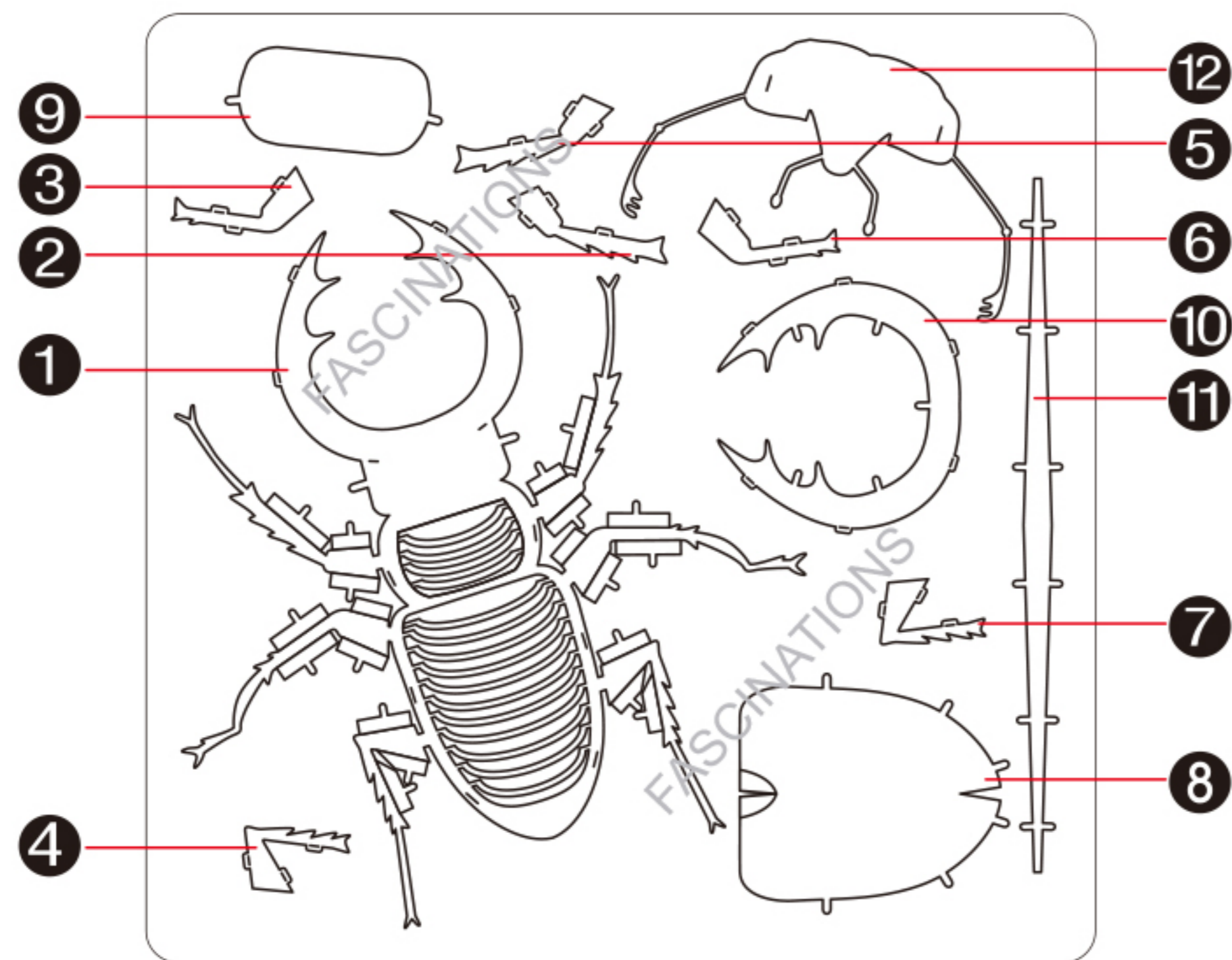


Insertion tabs are inserted and then folded

Insertion holes

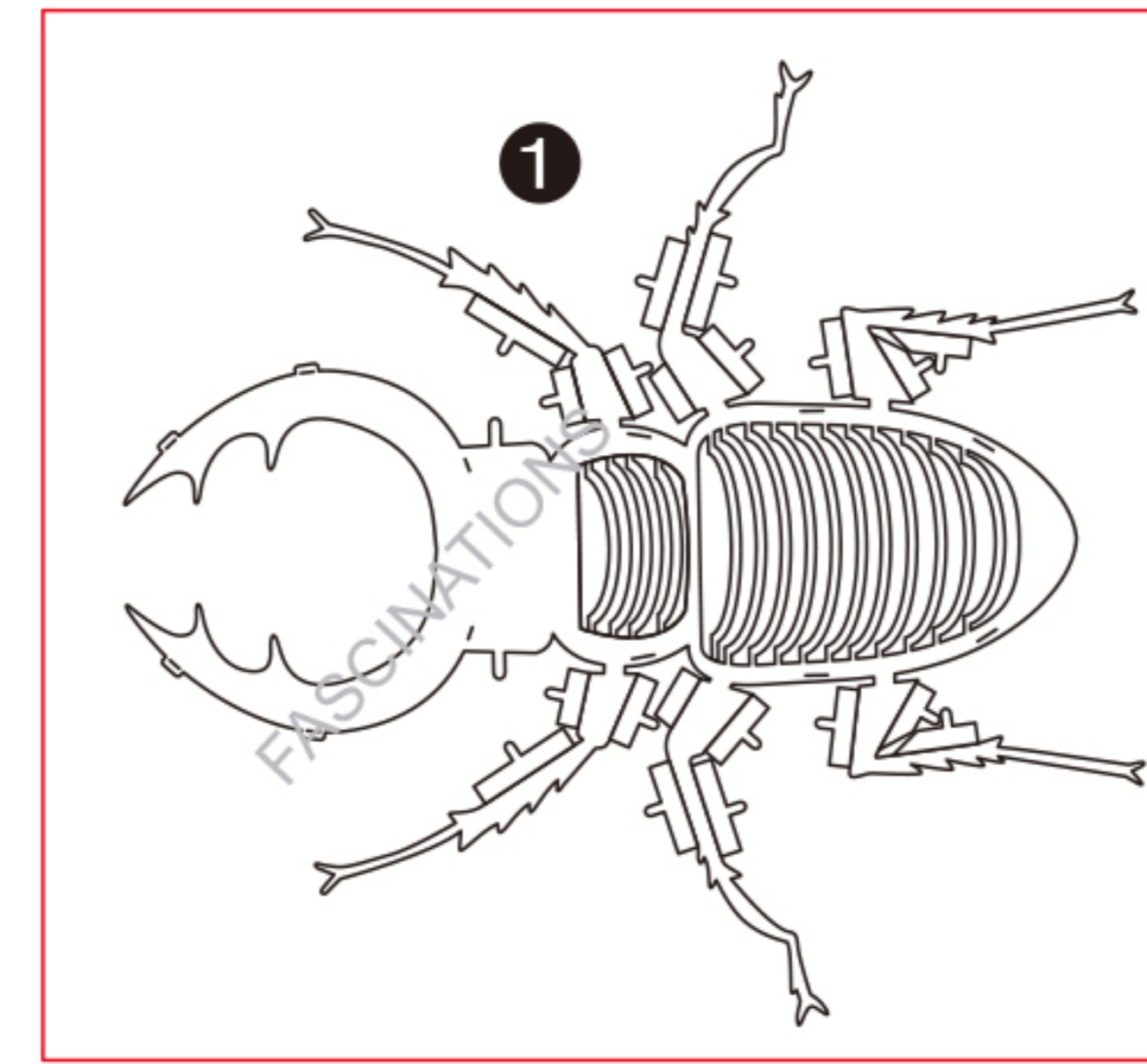
Fold lines can be seen as shown here

**Metal sheet**



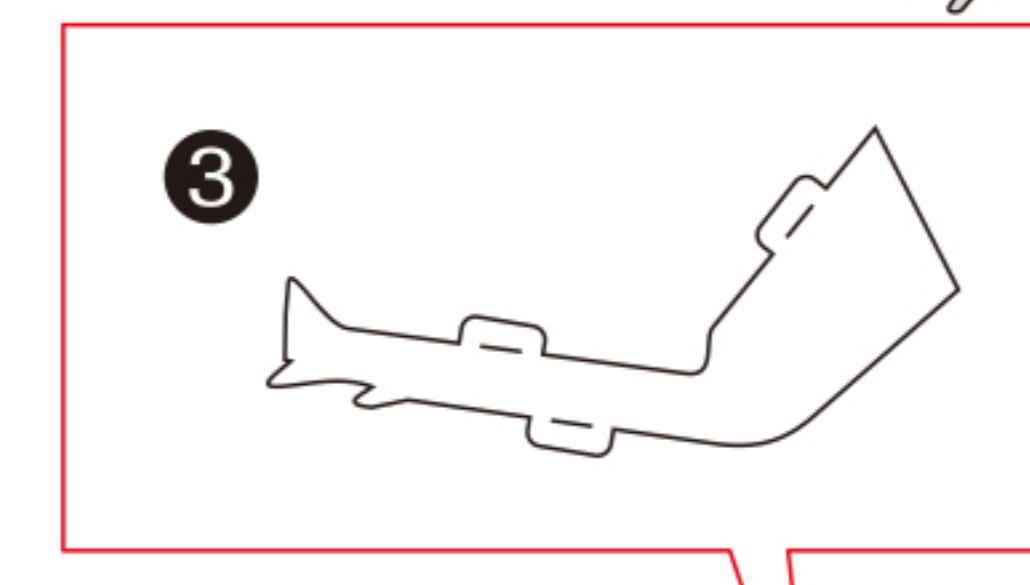
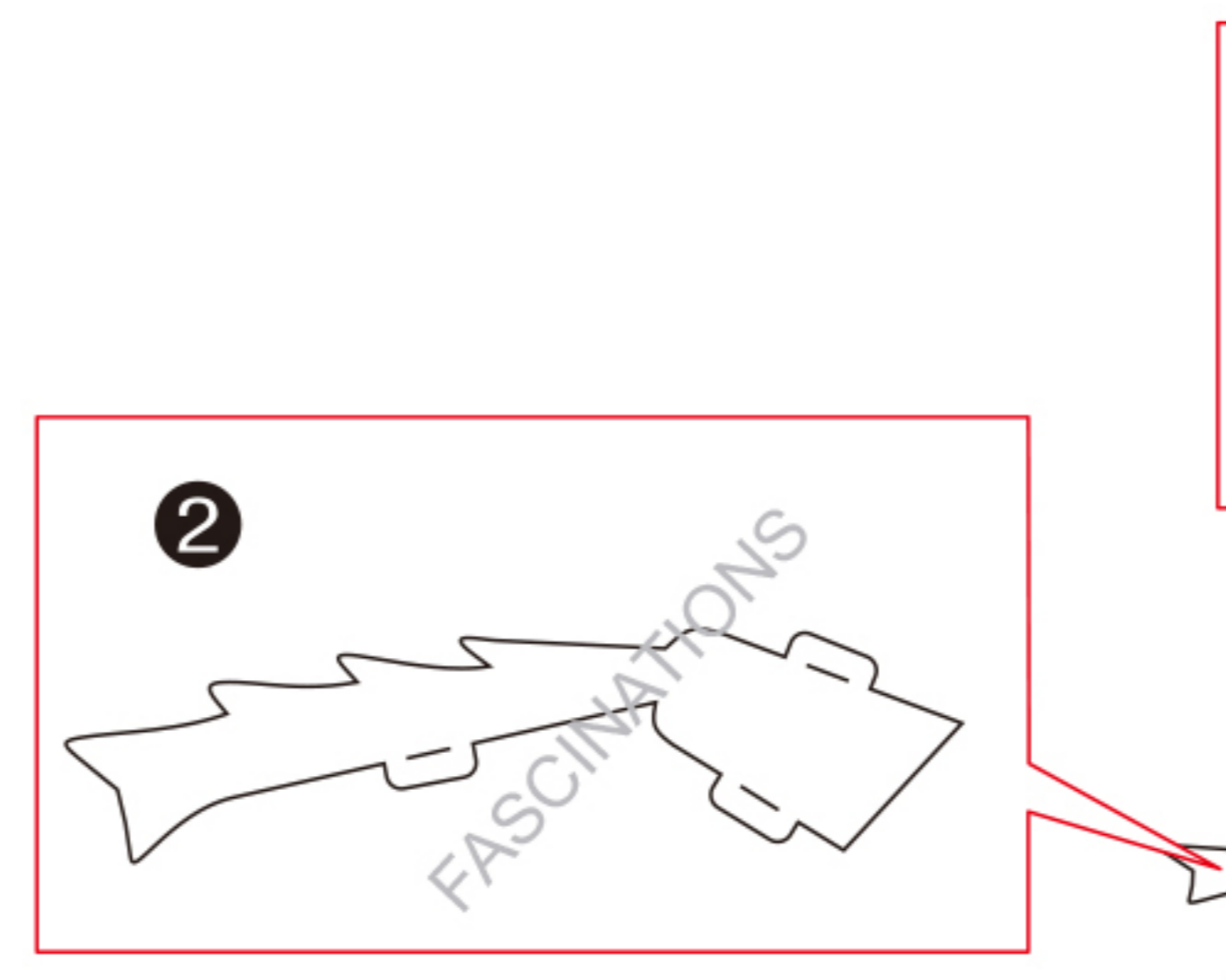
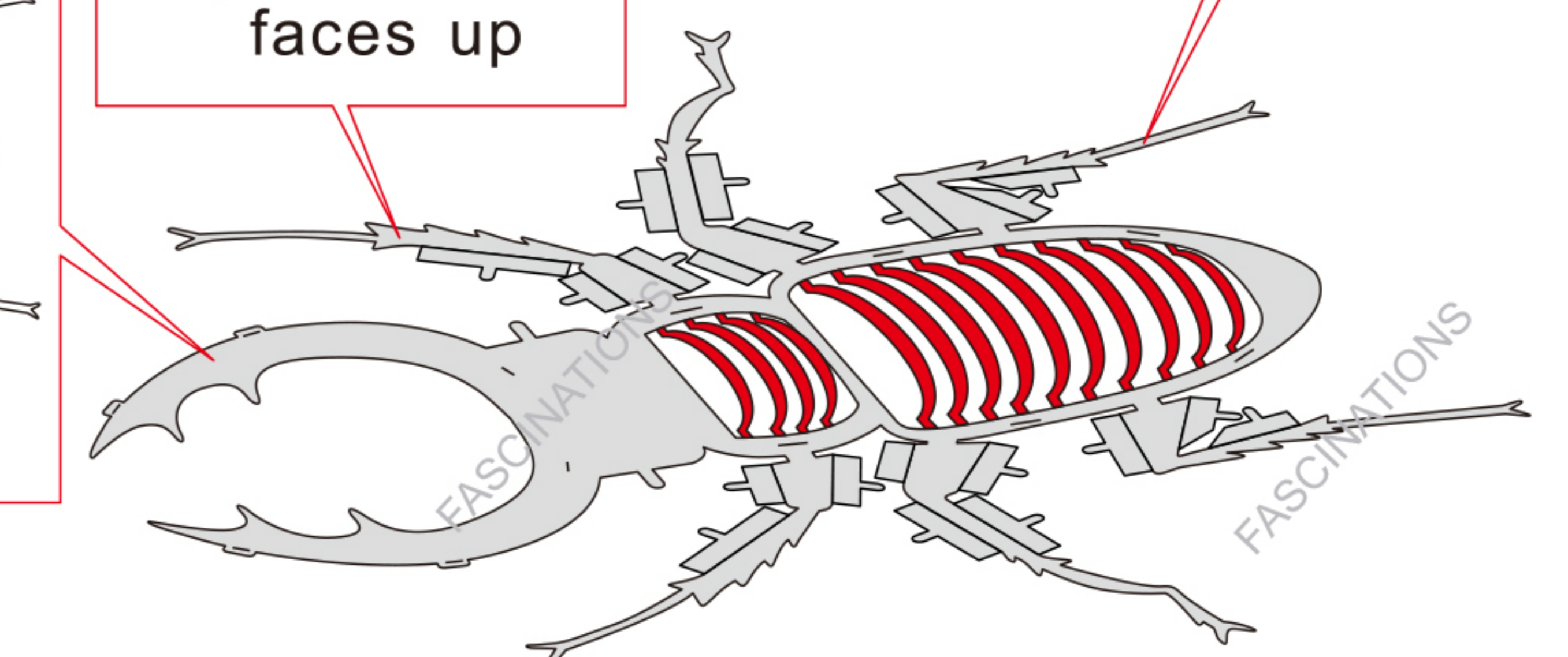
In order to avoid possible injury from sharp edges, please carefully discard the metal sheet after parts have been removed

**Assembly Flow Chart**

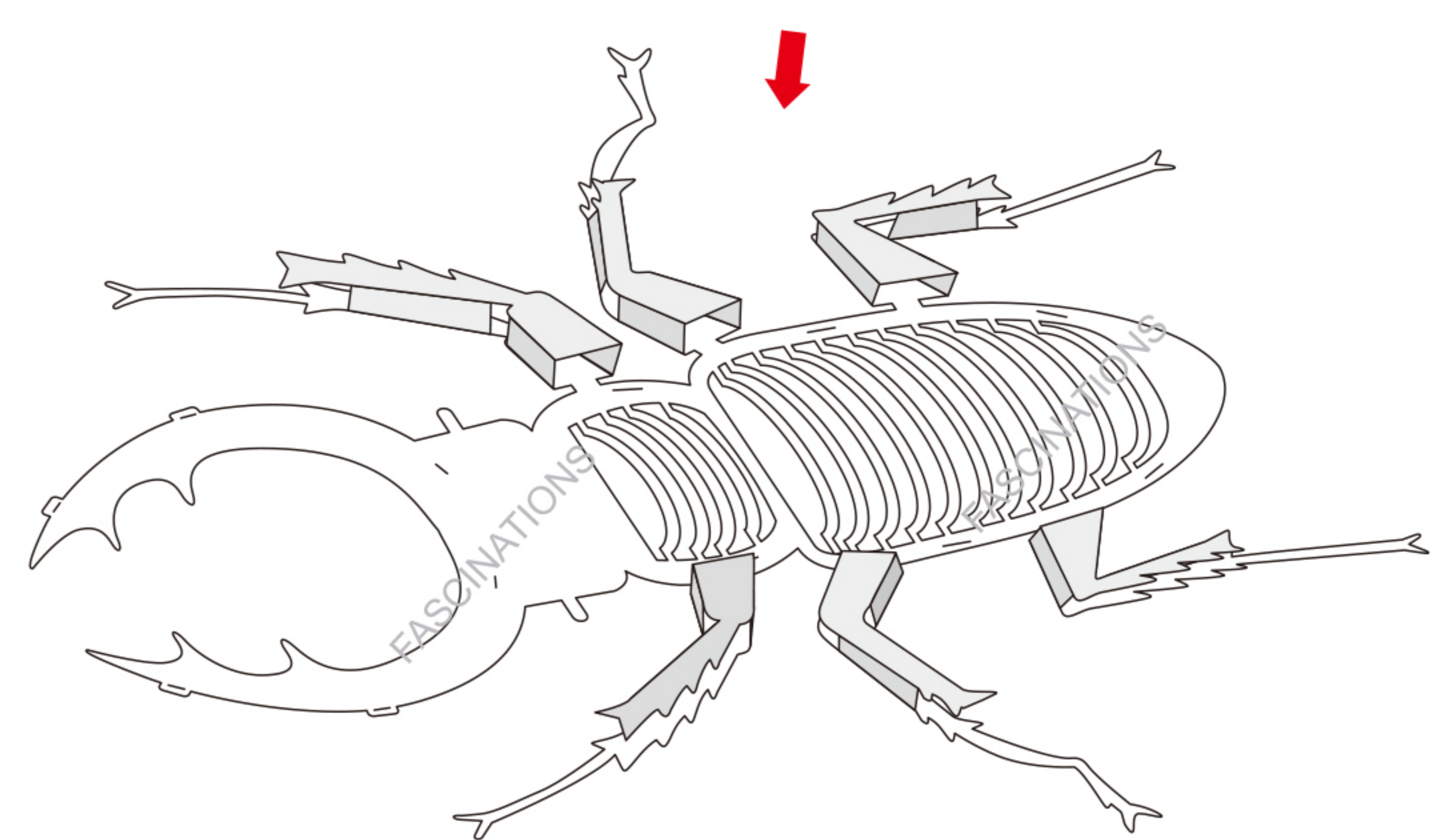
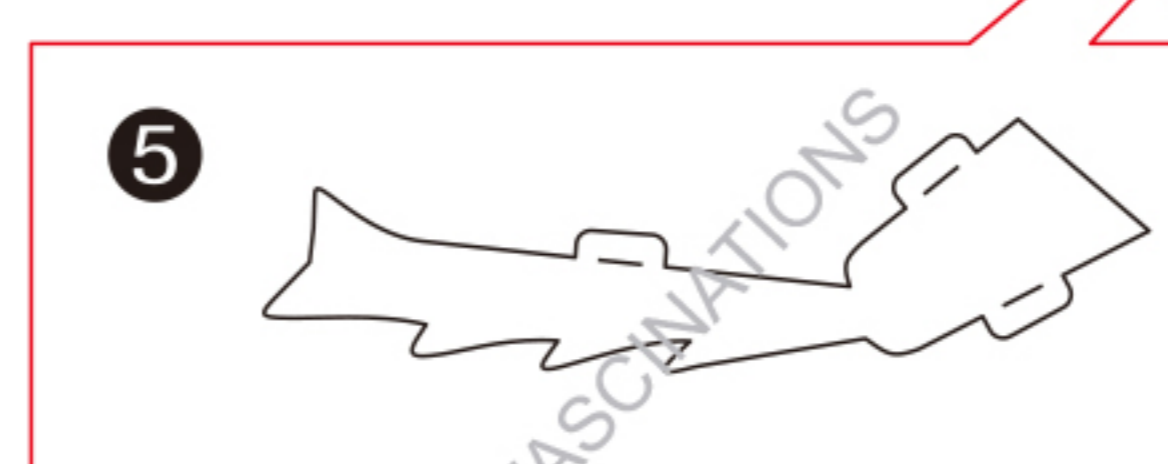
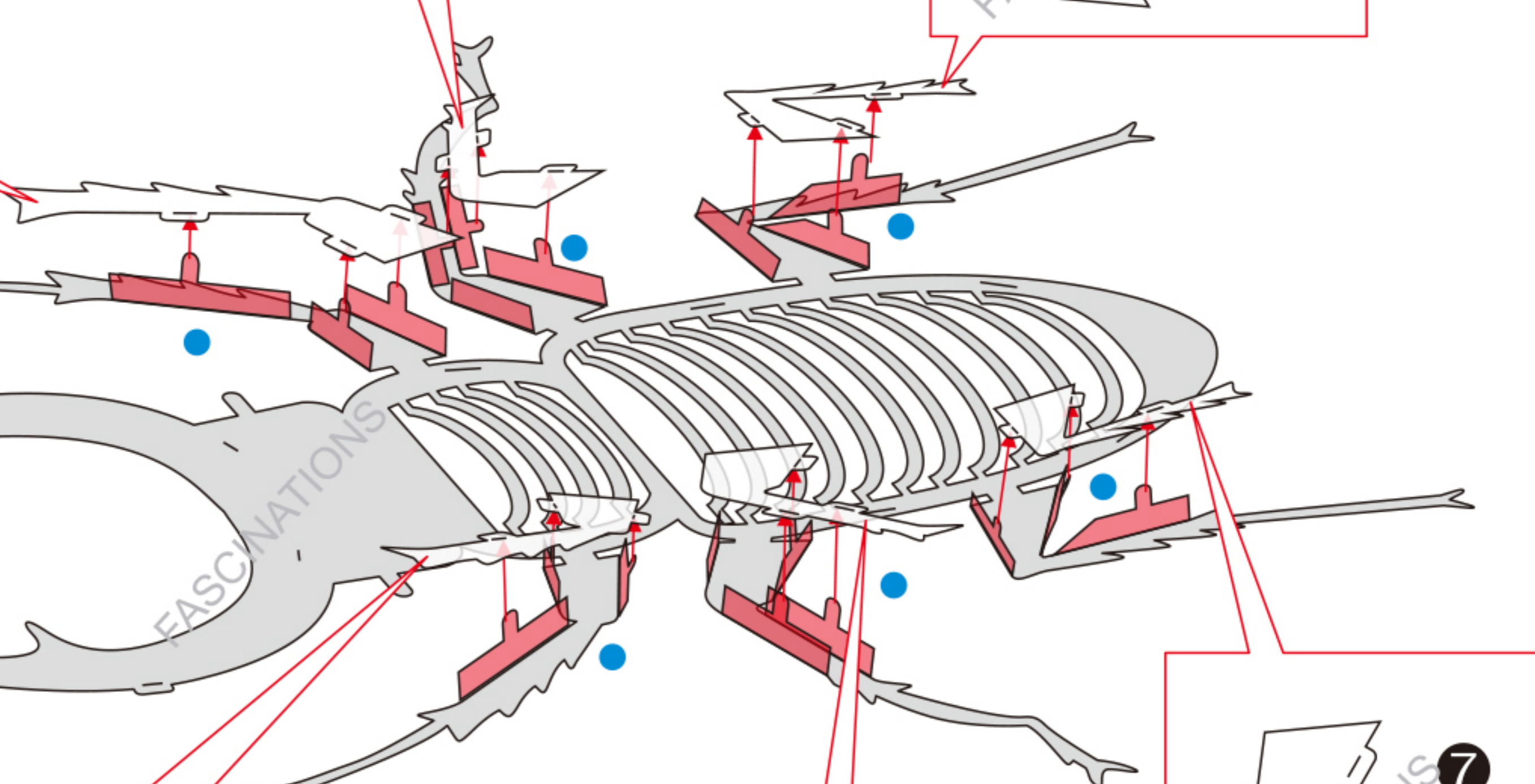
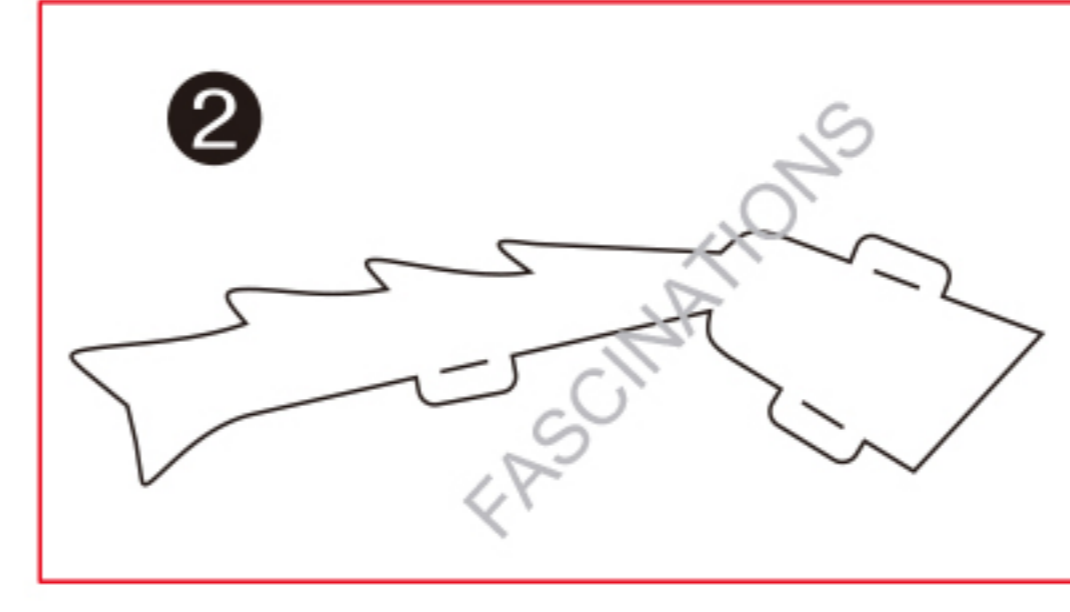


Engraved side faces up

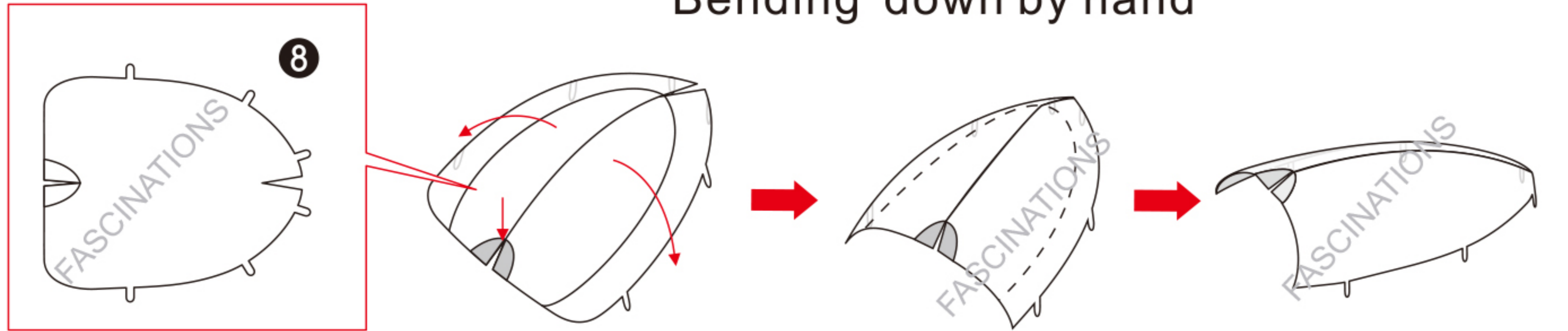
Bending up by hand. Tip: doing this step before taking part #1 out of the metal sheet



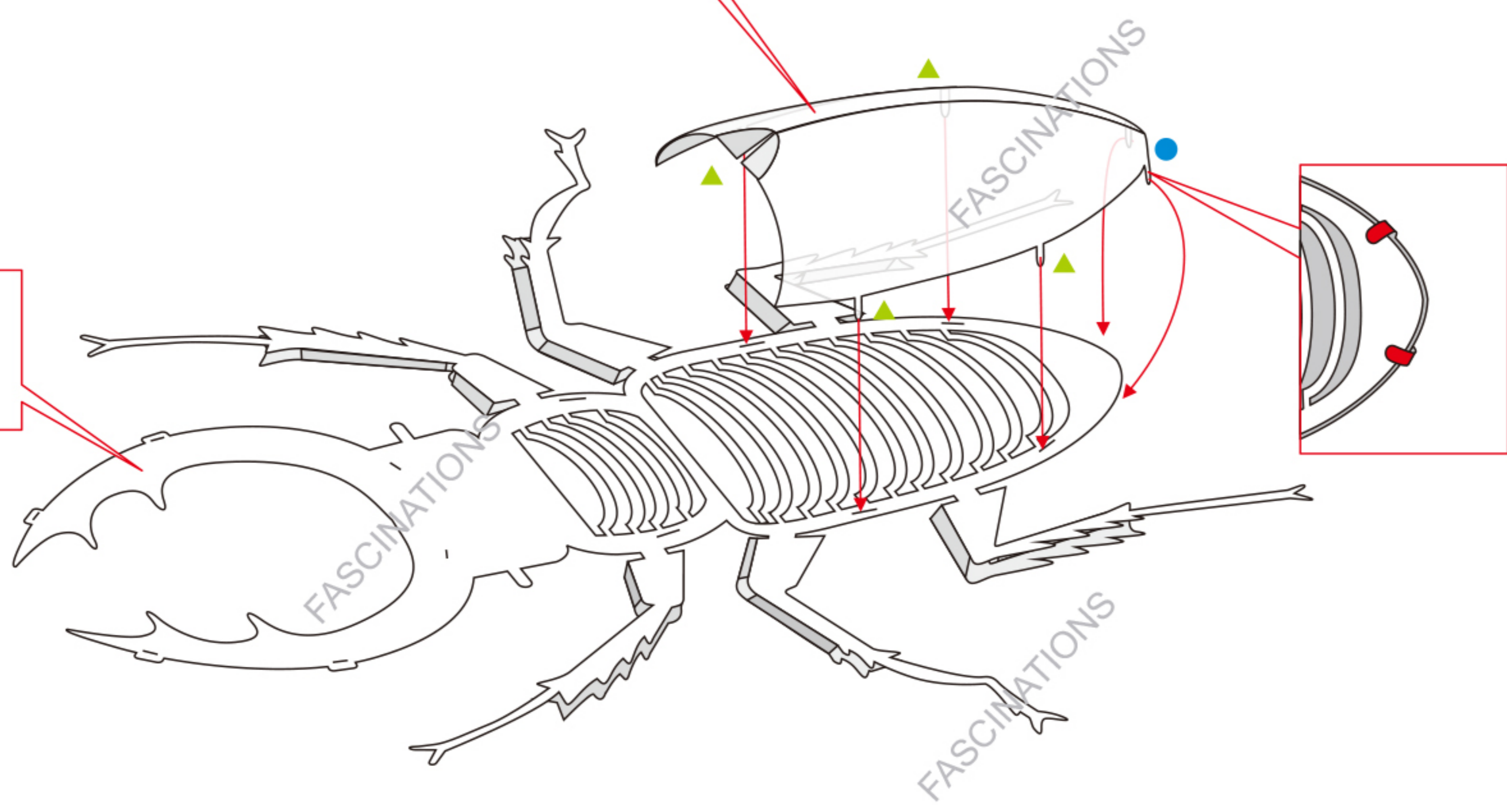
Engraved side faces up



**Bending down by hand**

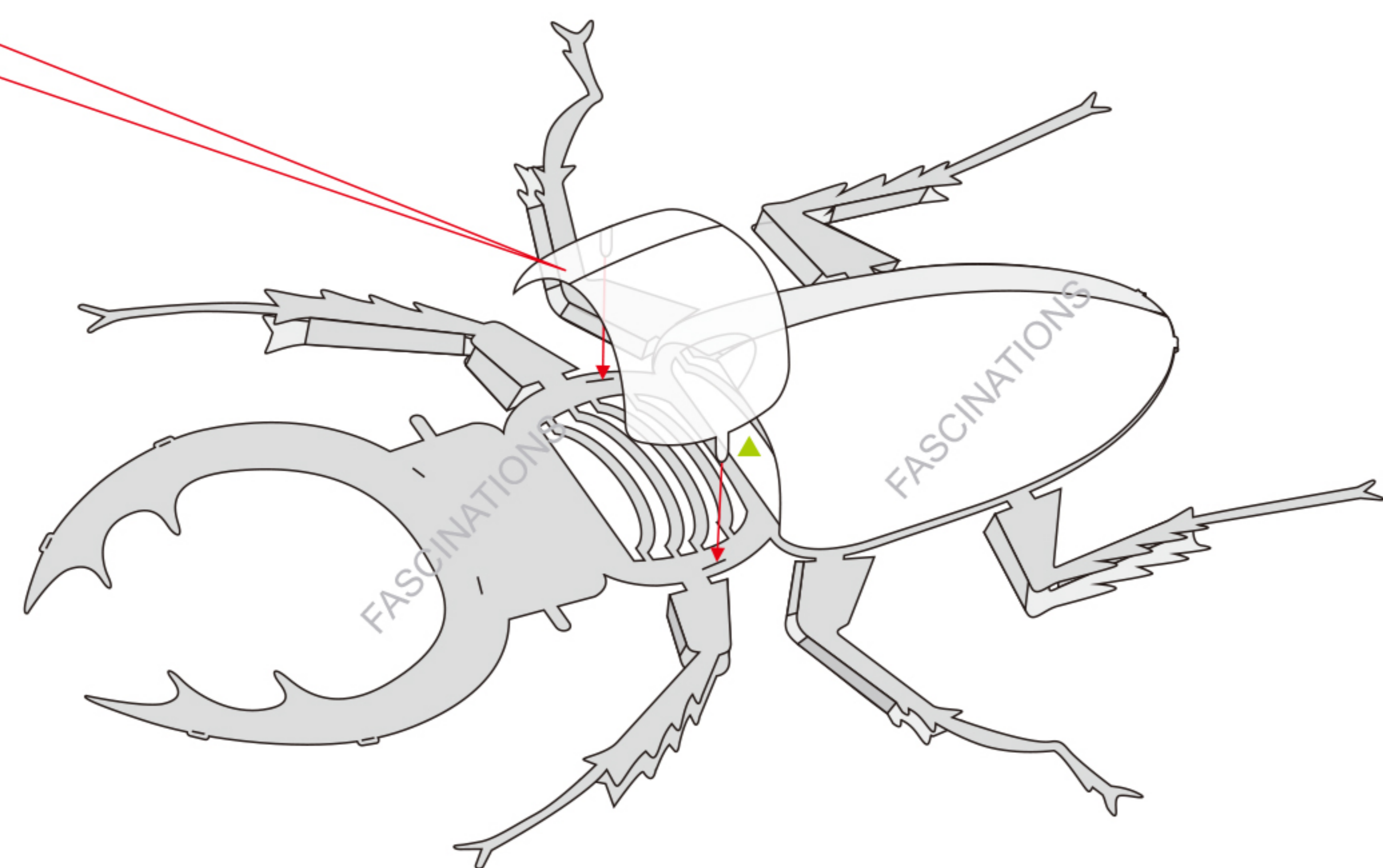
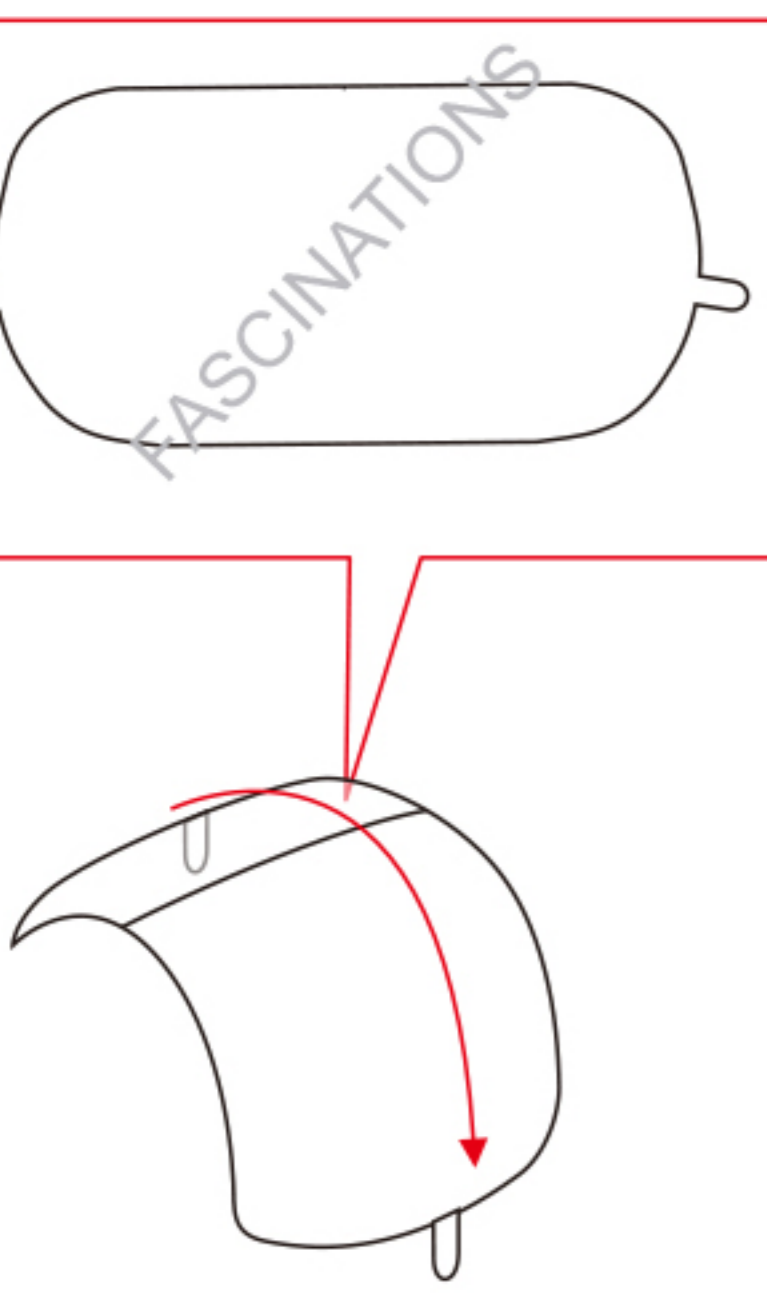


Engraved side faces down

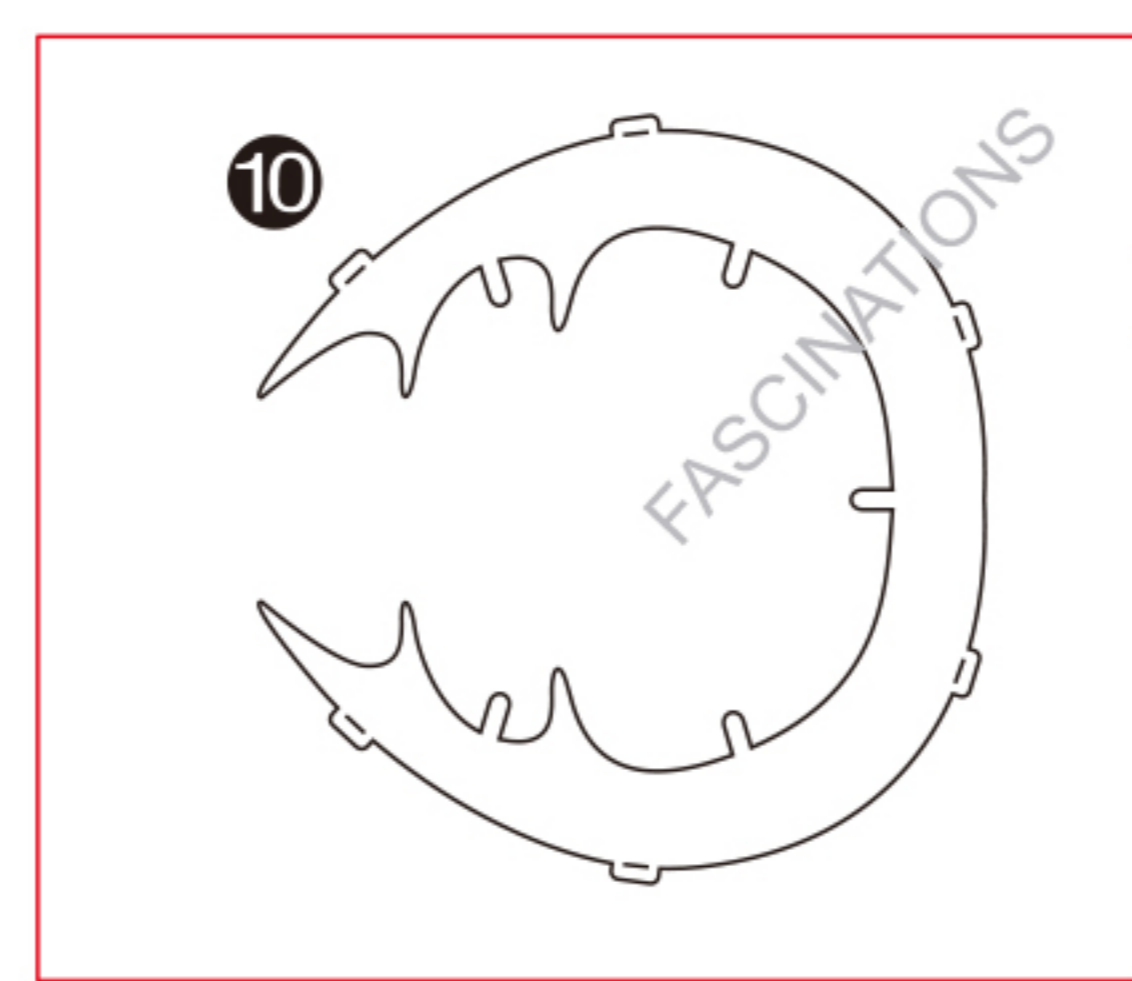
